**APPLICABILITY/ACCOUNTABILITY:**

This policy applies to all students, faculty, staff, and visitors.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

UCF's Reflecting Pond, completed in 1967, was one of the first structures built on campus. The 225,000-gallon concrete pond serves as a hub for university events and activities, and provides an iconic background for all to enjoy and photograph.

**POLICY STATEMENT:**

To ensure a safe and healthy environment for the university community, entry into the Reflecting Pond without official pre-approval is prohibited.


**POLICY:**

The University of Central Florida does not permit events or activities to take place within the Reflecting Pond, with the exception of Homecoming Spirit Splash, academic coursework, or other official activities pre-approved through the SAFE form process. Student violation of the Rules of Conduct may result in disciplinary action through the Student Conduct Board.

1. No individuals or pets may wade or swim in the Reflecting Pond.
2. No items (such as floating objects, glitter, confetti, or soap) may be placed or thrown into the Reflecting Pond.
3. Scheduled or unscheduled maintenance activities by university staff or contractors are exempt from this policy.
